

Effective April 6th, City of Versailles facilities will extend the initial closed to the public order in an effort to ensure Versailles is doing its part to assist in mitigating the potential for community spread of the Covid-19 virus.

This will apply to City Hall as well as all City Parks. This action is based on local health officials recommendation and the President social distancing stay. The guidelines are in effect to April 30th and may be extended or ceased at that time.

All City facilities were initial closed to the public effective March 19. Mayor Terry Silvey issued the following statement “ Covid-19 is a rapidly evolving situation, and as we have seen in the last week alone, the way we conduct business and provide services must also respond to that change.

The City of Versailles will continue to provide our normal services and City Hall will be manned under normal operating hours to assist and help our citizens, but the way we offer those services have to adapt for the time being! Our efforts are to keep the public safe by limiting non essential contact and social distancing. The City will re evaluate these measures on April 6th.

City business should be handled by phone and email for the time being. Details are as follows:

City Hall: Hours are 8: 00 am to 4: 30 pm Monday thru Friday. The front door access will be closed, but there is a drop box outside City Hall that you can drop your utility billing and payments off; building permits and applications can be dropped off there as well. Payments can also be made over the phone by calling 573-539-2576 or 573-539-2578. If you pay in cash, have the correct amount or it will be credited to your next payment billing.

For AMEREN payments: Include your account number and the correct amount and place in the drop box outside City Hall. You can also make a payment by calling the Ameren office directly at 573-552-7583.

Municipal court will accept payments using the drop box method or there is a link on the City's website at www.cityofversaillesmo.com to do online payments. Questions can be answered at 573-539-2590.

Police Department front door will be open during normal operating hours, there's an area to file reports, complaints, share paperwork and ask for an officer. For non emergency questions call 573-378-4634 and listen to the prompt.

Public works facility will be closed to the public, for questions, contact 573-378-0645

Waste Management will continue to pick up trash on your normal days

Code Enforcement involving animal control, building permits, other issues contact 573-569-4821.

We encourage you to check our website and face book page for current and future updates. We will keep KS-95 and the Versailles Leader Statesman advised to updates as well.

The decision to close City facilities to the public was not taken lightly. I am confident that this decision will assist in protecting the public against the possible spread of COVID-19. The decision was made as a way for the City to support social distancing as recommended by the CDC and health professionals. The City is doing our part to manage this crisis for the time being.
